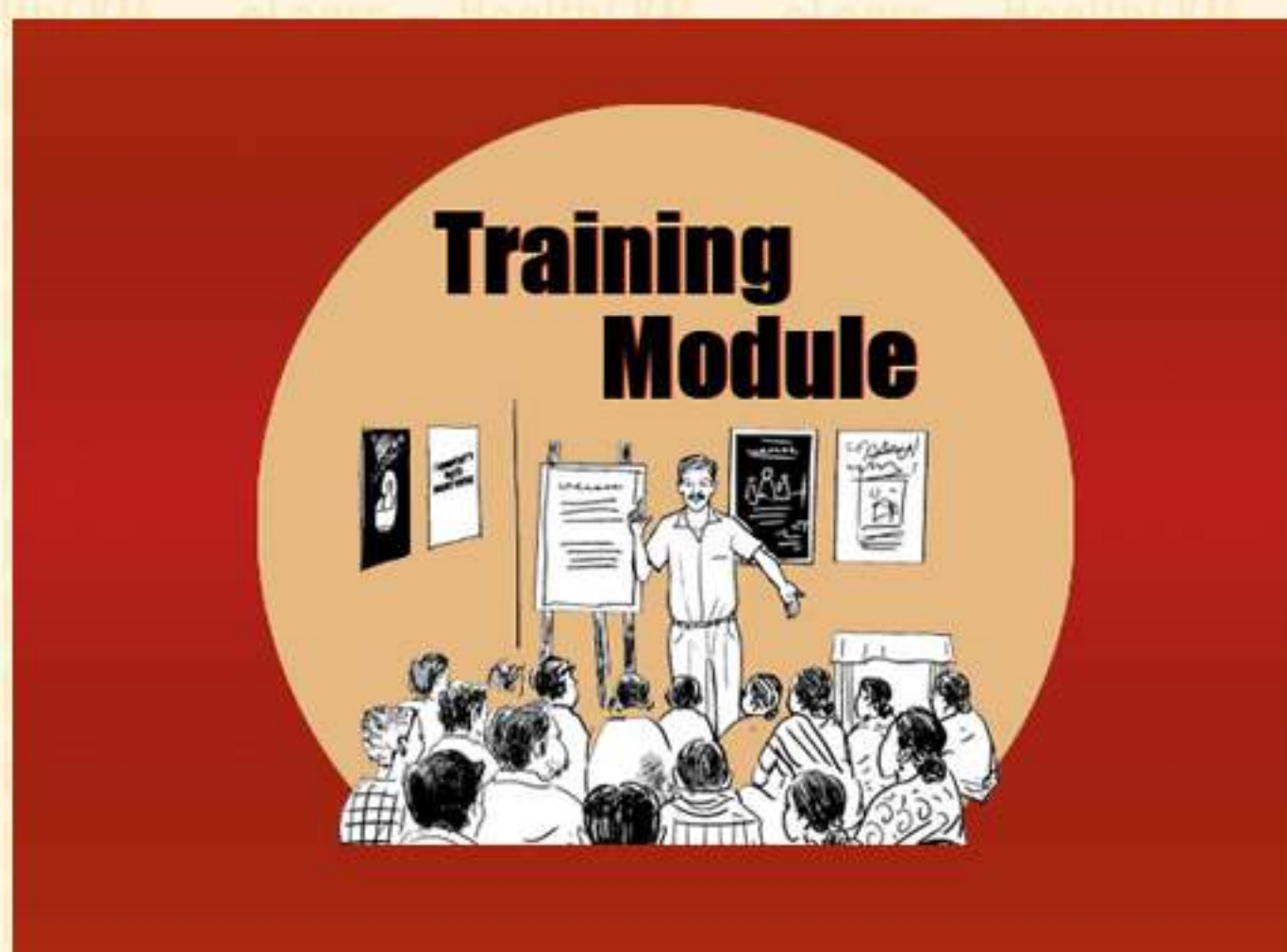
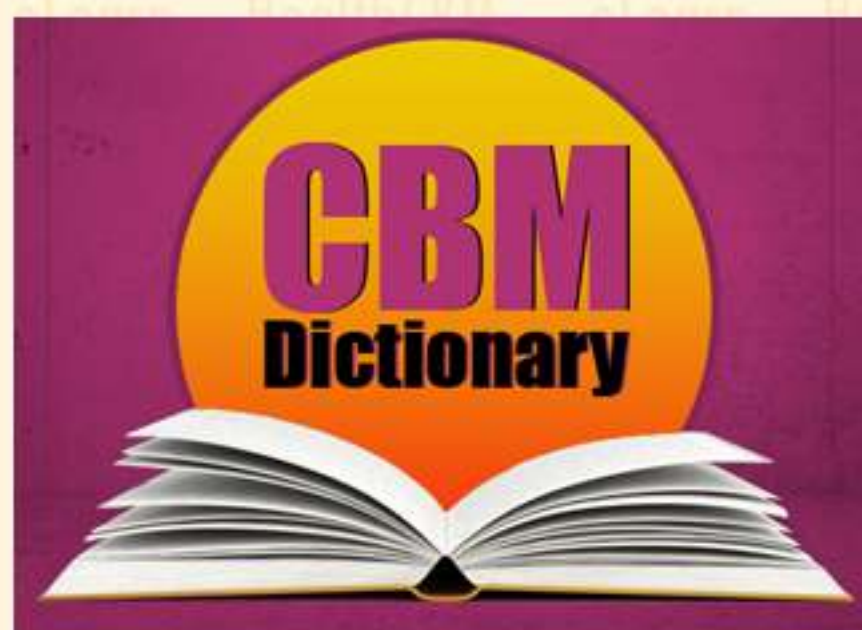

- The advocacy for health rights by using CBM

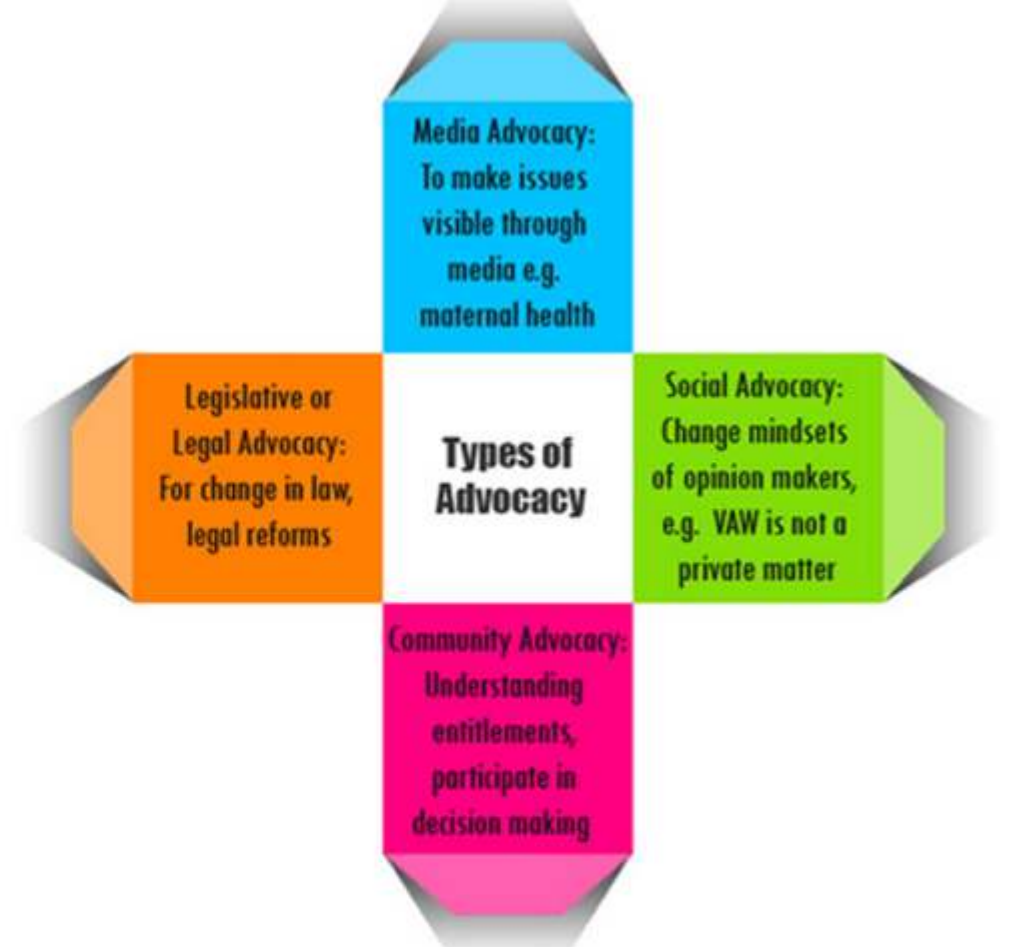
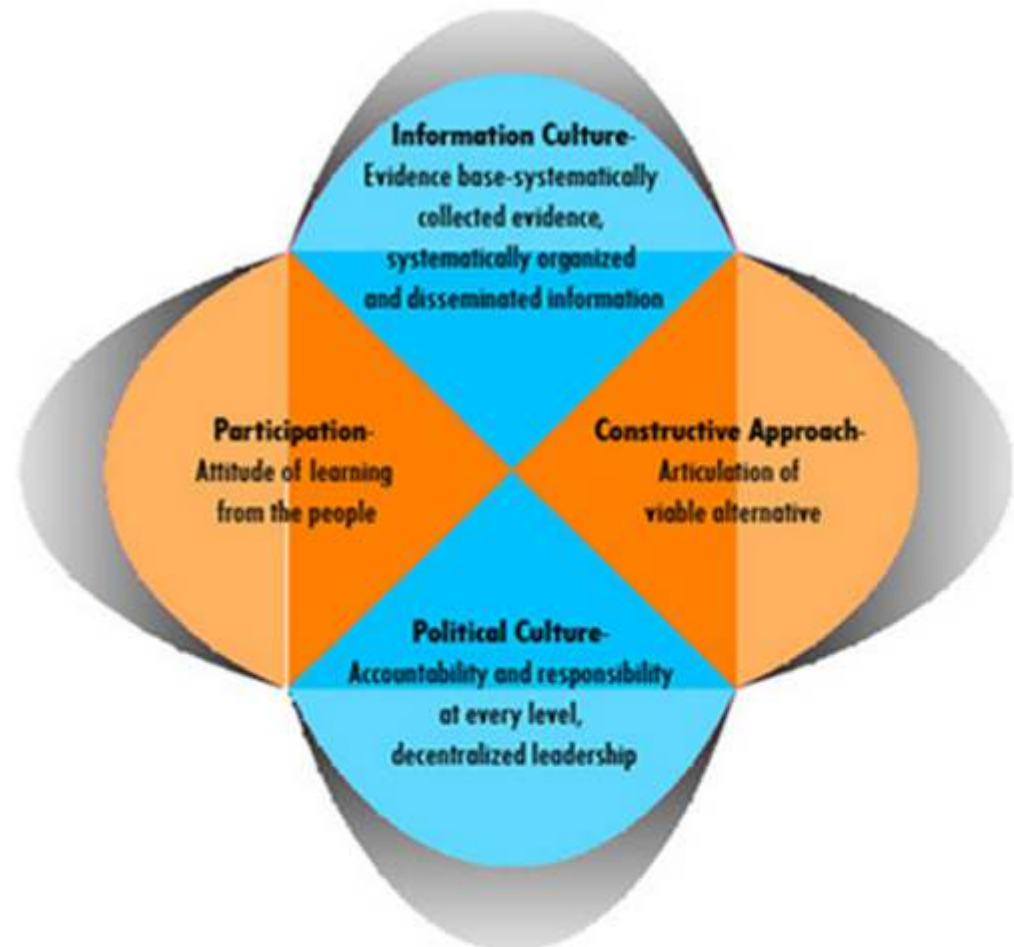
